### Kangan Institute

Kangan Institute also provided data on the number of young people under 16 years of age enrolled in 2011. This data includes young people studying pre-apprenticeships, VCAL and VCE programs, but does not include VET in Schools (as those young people would still be enrolled at a school) or short courses. The 328 students reported by Kangan Institute for 2011 were almost entirely aged 15 when they enrolled.

There were approximately 2,500 students who were enrolled in Year 9 or Year 10 in all government schools in Hume in the same period. This 328 students appear to represent a large proportion of the students who began school in Year 7 in Hume schools but do not complete Year 12.
